2) School Community Updates

- A few student transfers in and out over the last couple of weeks. Currently have an enrollment of 288
- Questions about vacations and extended vacations (30+ days absent, a child may be unenrolled IF the school is full at the child's grade level and a family moves into the catchment in need of that space).
- Questions about letters of reference or recommendation for private school (typically not provided by teachers)
- Volleyball is underway with a Grade 6/7 Boys team and Grade 7 Girls team thank you coaches (Allan, Ping, Erin) – and parent drivers who are helping students get to Norma Rose Point for games

3) Remembrance Day and Indigenous Veteran's Day Recognition

- Pre-recorded and shared with classes this evening to be shown tomorrow between recess and lunch
- Included an acknowledgement of Indigenous Veterans' Day (Nov. 8th) as well as

Remembrance Day

- Contributions of artwork, poetry, song and information from 4 classes
- Classes have the option to make a class wreath which will be placed at the front of our school tomorrow afternoon
- Families have the option to donate \$2 on School Cash Online to go towards the Poppy Fund
