


Queen Mary PAC uses a general parliamentary procedure which includes:

- When ready to forward or second a motion or vote, "Raise Hand"







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
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### Motion To Approve: April Meeting Minutes



✓Last day of school for students is June 29 School Fees for 2022-2023 ✓ School supply fee - \$35. Activity fee - \$25. 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### PAC Financials - The Tale of Two Accounts

1

#### General Account

**Source of Funds:** Funds are raised through PAC fundraising events, programs, and direct drives

Use of Funds: Teachers are able to enrich the classroom experience and environment through some of the funds raised, field trips may be supported, computers and other technology purchased, books purchased for the library, educational seminars offered, gardens planted, etc.

The only restriction on use of funds is approval by the PAC

#### Gaming Account

**Source of Funds:** Community Gaming Grant is available each year with eligible PACs receiving grant funds equivalent to \$20 per student enrolled in the previous year

**Use of Funds:** Gaming grants are very helpful to community schools but do come with a number of restrictions.

Grant funding is intended to benefit all students by enhancing the <u>extracurricular</u> <u>opportunities</u> of students who attend the school(s) represented by the PAC
